SENIOR MANAGEMENT DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

In line with the Club's objective to further enhance the professional standard practice and management of Malaysian Business, the HBSACM organised seven Senior Management Development Programs i.e. in 1979, 82, 84, 86, 88, 90 & 92. It is one of the first to do so in Malaysia and well over 600 Senior Managers have attended the Program. Through this program the Club hopes to contribute towards the development of professional business management in Malaysia.

The SMDP participants will attend full time preferably without interruption from home or office for the duration of the Program. They are taught by full-time faculty who utilise the case method. Executives are encouraged to share experience and learn from each other in and out of the classroom. New concepts, research findings, management issues and teaching materials are continuously expounded by the distinguished teaching faculty of four leading professors from the Harvard Business School.

The Program is designed to heighten the understanding of the important elements in the Management area, such as Marketing, Corporate financial Management, Human Resources, Information Technology, Organisational Behaviour, Strategy and Competition etc.

The Senior Management Development Program contributes to the professional development of the practicing managers who have potential for larger responsibilities.



TRUST FUND

The Harvard Business School Alumni Club of Malaysia established a Trust Fund by a Trust Deed on 26th March 1984. The main aim of the Fund is for the promotion and dissemination of knowledge and education in business studies and other related subjects. In pursuance of this desires, the Trustees established the Harvard Business School Alumni Club of Malaysia Foundation.

Various sums of money have been donated and or subscribed to the Foundation since then and the sum standing to the Foundation's credit is about \$700,000.

Under the aegis of the Foundation, various activities are carried out such as Scholarships for the pursuing Post graduate degree in local/foreign universities. Various studies have been undertaken by the Club such as:

- (a) Technology Acquisition and Technological Capability Development in Malaysia, Role of Multinational Corporations Host Agencies.
- (b) Financing for Development – External Debts versus Director Foreign Investment (with special reference to Malaysia)
- (c) A study of Wage Trends and Wage Systems in Malaysia.

3 Scholarship awards have been given to undergraduates pursuing post-graduate studies in Business Studies.

LIBRARY

The professional managers face important contemporary issues such as Information systems where technological developments is changing firms, organisational structures, management control systems and the general infrastructure. Hence they have to refresh their lessons as well as learn the latest in Business Administration. Hence the need for a reference Library for the members of the Harvard Business School Club of Malaysia. The Library contains the latest in Information Technology, Corporate Financial Management, Marketing, Organisational behaviour, Corporate Strategy, Human Resource Management etc.

The Library is at present temporarily situated in the office of a Past President but the Club is actively looking for a permanent place.

MANAGER OF THE YEAR AWARD



The Manager of the Year Award is the Club's contribution towards encouraging and promoting excellence in professional business management in the country.

The award is given to the Chief Executive Officer of an organisation. The Chief Executive Officer should have been on the job for more than three years and the evaluation is based on the financial performance of his organisation as well as qualitative factors such as innovation, contribution to society, and management profession, training and development.

All organisations are incorporated in Malaysia and listed in the Kuala Lumpur Stock Exchange.



The Manager of the Year will be awarded a cash prize of \$10,000, a plaque and a certificate which will be presented at the Award Dinner...such awards had been made until 1992.

GOLD MEDAL AWARD

The Harvard Business School Alumni Club of Malaysia awards a Gold Medal annually to honour the most outstanding Business Administration student graduating from the faculties of Economics/Business Administration from the 6 Universities in Malaysia. The award is to encourage and give recognition to the successful student who had achieved excellence in pursuing the study of Business Administration. This is in line with the objective of the Club to promote greater interest amongst Students pursuing Business Studies to become management professionals for the development of the country.

A selection committee consisting of the Vice President of the HBSACM, a senior official from the Ministry of Education and other Executive members select the best student evaluating the graduate's high performance during his university examinations, his extra mural activities in which he has taken part such as sports, participation as member of various committees in Colleges and University level, representing University in national/international level. The final selection is done by an interview with the graduates to test their application of their book knowledge to every day life.

To date, 10 Gold Medal Awards have been given by the Club. The Award consists of a Gold Medal, \$1,000 in cash and a Certificate.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The Harvard Business School Alumni Club of Malaysia has established a Foundation with the aim of providing loans, scholarships, grants or other financial assistance to persons engaged in the study of Business Studies and other related fields. With this aim, the Foundation awards financial assistance to the eligible candidates to pursue their post graduate studies in local or foreign universities.

The candidate must be a Malaysian Citizen and should have at least a Second Class Upper Honours degree from a recognised University or its equivalent. He/she must have been admitted for full-time studies leading to a Doctorate or Masters Degree in Business Studies in an approved institution of higher learning in the year of Scholarship. The Scholarship is tenable for 2 years. The candidate is required to sign a performance bond with the Club but is not however required to be otherwise bonded to work for the club or its sponsor.

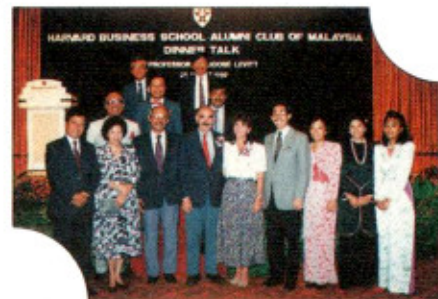
